## The Lord's Church

The word church is singular not plural. The Lord only promised to build His **one church.** In Ephesians 4:4-6 we read, "There is **one body**, and one Spirit, even as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all, and in you all." Just as there is only one God, there is only one body. What is this **one body**? In Ephesians 1:21-22 we find out what this **one body** is, "And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to **the church, which is His body.**" Here we see that the Bible says the church is the body. So the **one body** is the **one church** which belongs to the Lord. One might as well believe in more than one God as to believe that the Lord has more than one church. Today we hear the sincere but mistaken plea to "attend the church of your choice." ## "Is God a Resident Or Guest?"

In creating a strong family life centered on God, there must be shared time together. Moses commanded Israel: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up" (Deuteronomy 6:5-8). Moses' timeless advice is the foundation for Biblical spirituality in the home. Time together is the bonding mortar that brings us together before God in our lives. You never know when you are making a memory with your children. Deuteronomy repeatedly emphasizes the need for parents to heartily "love" God, to avoid another lost generation as in the wilderness wandering (Deuteronomy 10:12 - 11:32). For God to be first in our lives, His will must be regularly discussed and applied in our daily home life. What we truly love most of all will show up in our priorities, what we talk about, and how we use our time. In Deuteronomy 6, Moses urges us to discuss God's will "when you lie down." This refers to daily bedtime. Kiss your children goodnight. Read to them or listen to them read from the Bible or a Bible devotional. "When you rise up" is beginning the day with God. Besides giving thanks at breakfast, give your child a Bible verse for the day, like from (Proverbs. 9:10) "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." The family meal time is a good way to be together "when you sit in your house." We thank God for our blessings to our lives. DAN
