WHY SHOULD WE GIVE

GENEROUSLY?

The Bible teaches us to give of our means on the first day of the week (1 Cor. 16:2). It also teaches us to give bountifully (2 Cor. 9:6), liberally, generously and plentifully. There are several reasons why this is so.

- 1. We should give generously because we are to give as God gives to us, as he prospers us (1 Cor. 16:2). Not only does God lavish material blessings on us but think of the rich spiritual ones He has given, the greatest which was the gift of His Son. "Thanks be to God for his unspeakable gift" (2 Cor. 9:15).
- 2. We should give generously because we are to be like His Son (1 Pet. 2:21) and that is the way He has given to us. "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for our sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might become rich" (2 Cor. 8:9).
- 3. We should give generously because of our deep gratitude for all the things God has done for us and gives to us. "What shall I render unto Jehovah for all his benefits toward me?" (Ps. 116:12).
- 4. We should give generously because of our respect for God and His cause. We wouldn't give leftovers or that which was no good to someone on earth we respected. The prophet reproved the people for giving things to God they wouldn't give to the governor (Malachi 1:8).
- 5. We should give generously because we know we can't out give God. We do not give just to receive, but we know that if we give we will receive for the law of sowing and reaping is, "He that soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he that soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully" (2 Cor. 9:6).
