"Let Me Bless Others"

We should all want to be a channel of blessing to others. Paul expressed his desire to be used as a channel of blessing in Philippians 1:20-21, "According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain." The song "Make Me A Channel Of Blessing" conveys the lesson that the servant of the LORD can be the useful instrument, the channel of blessing, from God to those in need. Consider the first stanza, "Is your life a channel of blessing? Is the love of God flowing through you? Are you telling the lost of the Savior? Are you ready his service to do?" Paul wrote by inspiration to the church at Corinth, the church that did not always appreciate his leadership. "And I will very gladly spend and be spent for you; though the more abundantly I love you, the less I be loved" (2 Corinthians 12:15). This is Paul's way of saying, "I will lay everything, even my life, on God's altar for you." Your life can be a channel of blessing, if you will take up your cross and follow Jesus daily (Luke 9:23-24). If you follow the selfish, fleshly path, your life can also be a stumbling block (I Corinthians 8:9). Let us every day make that effort to bless someone else as God has blessed us. You will reap what you sow in life. Gal. 6. What are you sowing in your life? DAN
