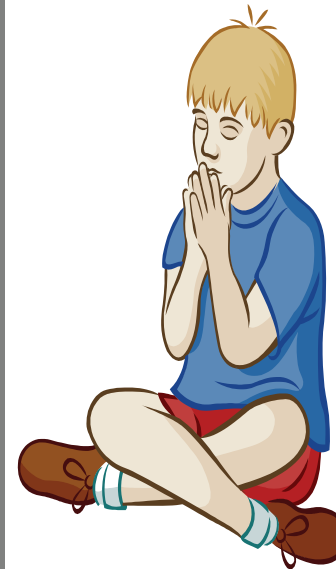

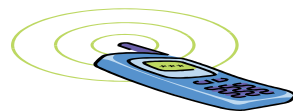

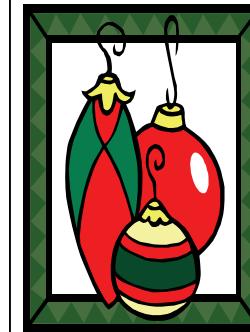


**CHRISTMAS
