"IMPATIENCE"

Impatience in material matters is bad enough, but it's especially destructive when it rears its ugly head in even more important areas of life. If patience has not been developed early in life, young people will likely become impatient in fulfilling their sexual urges, and will convince themselves that they "deserve" the pleasures reserved for marriage--especially if they are "in love." Christians must fight against impatience in dealing with one another. We are commanded to "be patient with all" (1 Thess. 5:14), including the unruly, faint-hearted and weak. In all our teaching we must show patience (2 Tim. 2:24). We may even become somewhat impatient with our own pursuit of righteousness. For that reason we are warned not to "grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart" (Gal. 6:9). God promises great things to "those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality" (Rom. 2:7). Even when our righteousness brings trouble to us in the short-term, we are reminded to be "patient in tribulation" (Rom. 12:12), for as we are reminded in another place, "be patient until the coming of the Lord...Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand" (Jas. 5:7-8).
